Services Offered and Prices as of August 1, 2018

Basic Surgical Packages (include injectable sedative pre-medication and general anesthesia):

Additional (Optional) Services

*Note: All prices are valid only for the day of the SNAP surgery.

Pain and Antibiotic Packages:

All cats will receive a short-acting pain medication with their pre-operative sedative. This pain medication lasts for approximately 1 – 3 hours in the cat's system. The basic package does not include any additional pain medications or antibiotics.

Viral Testing:

Feline leukemia virus (FeLV) and feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV) are both life-threatening diseases that can be passed from cat to cat. There is no cure for either of these diseases. We recommend FeLV/FIV testing for all cats, regardless of their history.

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Vaccinations:

We recommend the rabies vaccine as well as the "RCD" vaccine (rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and distemper or panleukopenia) for all cats as a part of their core vaccines. We recommend the FeLV vaccine for any cat that will be going outdoors. These vaccines are not required at the time of surgery to participate in SNAP.

(Note: ear mites generally require a second treatment in 30 days)

Declawing Options:

If you are considering declawing your cat, Dr. Pugh, Dr. Alison and Dr. Dittoe recommend having this procedure done at the same time as the spay or neuter. We believe that it is better for the health and wellbeing of the cat to only undergo one anesthetic event instead of two separate procedures and two separate anesthetic events. Both declaw packages include a 14-day antibiotic injection, a 24-hour pain injection, pain medication given each day in the hospital, therapy laser treatment, two nights' hospitalization, and pain medication to go home. Please call the clinic for a detailed estimate and to schedule.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The veterinarian reserves the right to conduct a thorough pre-surgery examination of the animal and to accept or reject the animal in its present condition. The veterinarian may disqualify the animal if, in his or her opinion, the animal is not medically sound to undergo surgery.

Payment of fee must be made to the veterinarian in full at time of pickup. Scheduled appointments must be cancelled 24 hours prior to the appointment or a penalty of \$15.00 will be assessed against the owner by the veterinarian.

I understand that all reasonable precautions against injury to escape will be taken and that there is some degree of inherent risk in the use of drugs, anesthesia or surgery and I hereby consent and authorize the doctors at Hometown Veterinary Services to receive, treat and perform surgery on the animal.

I understand and agree that the Spay Neuter Assistance Program – SNAP OF NE OHIO conducts this Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Program as a public service and that it refers pet owners only to licensed veterinarians; that, as a result therefore, the Spay Neuter Assistance Program – SNAP OF NE OHIO's Low-Cost Spay Neuter program and its participating veterinarians cannot and do not accept liability of complications arising from surgery. Therefore, for valuable consideration given, I hereby release and forever discharge the Spay Neuter Assistance Program – SNAP OF NE OHIO, the participating veterinarians and all employees, volunteers and representatives thereof from all claims, damages and causes of action that may arise from the surgery on my pet for which I am applying.
